Will keep you updated on progress.”</p> <p>Coppermill Primary School “The funds have been earmarked to fund a recycling project which has not yet been started. We will keep the Community Council informed”.</p> <p>Hillyfield Primary School “Containers and pots have been purchased together with bulbs and plants. They have been put all round the school area”.</p> <p>McEntee School “ The Walthamstow West Community Funding helped us to obtain all the necessary plants for an environmental area outside the Science Labs to aid student learning. This included plants for the pond as well as vegetables such as radishes, herbs and hosepipe and fittings. The funding also contributed to the pond liner.”</p>
