- **If Officer suspects person within ARZ has:**
 - Drunk alcohol
 - Intends to drink alcohol
- **He can:**
 - Pour away opened drink
 - Confiscate closed drink.
- **Failure to comply:**
 - **£50** penalty notice
 - Arrest & prosecute - max **£500**
 - Bail conditions

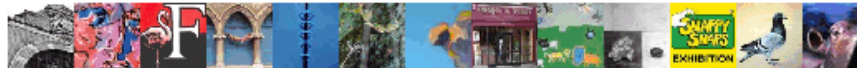
2008 will see the 4th annual E17 Art Trail, and after the excitement of last year, we are really looking forward to it.

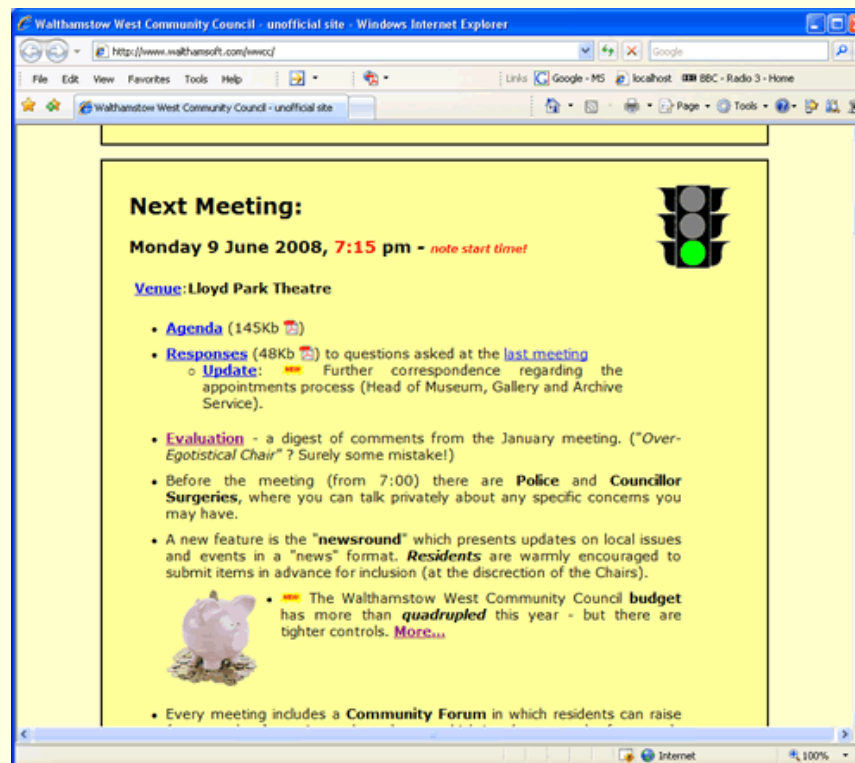

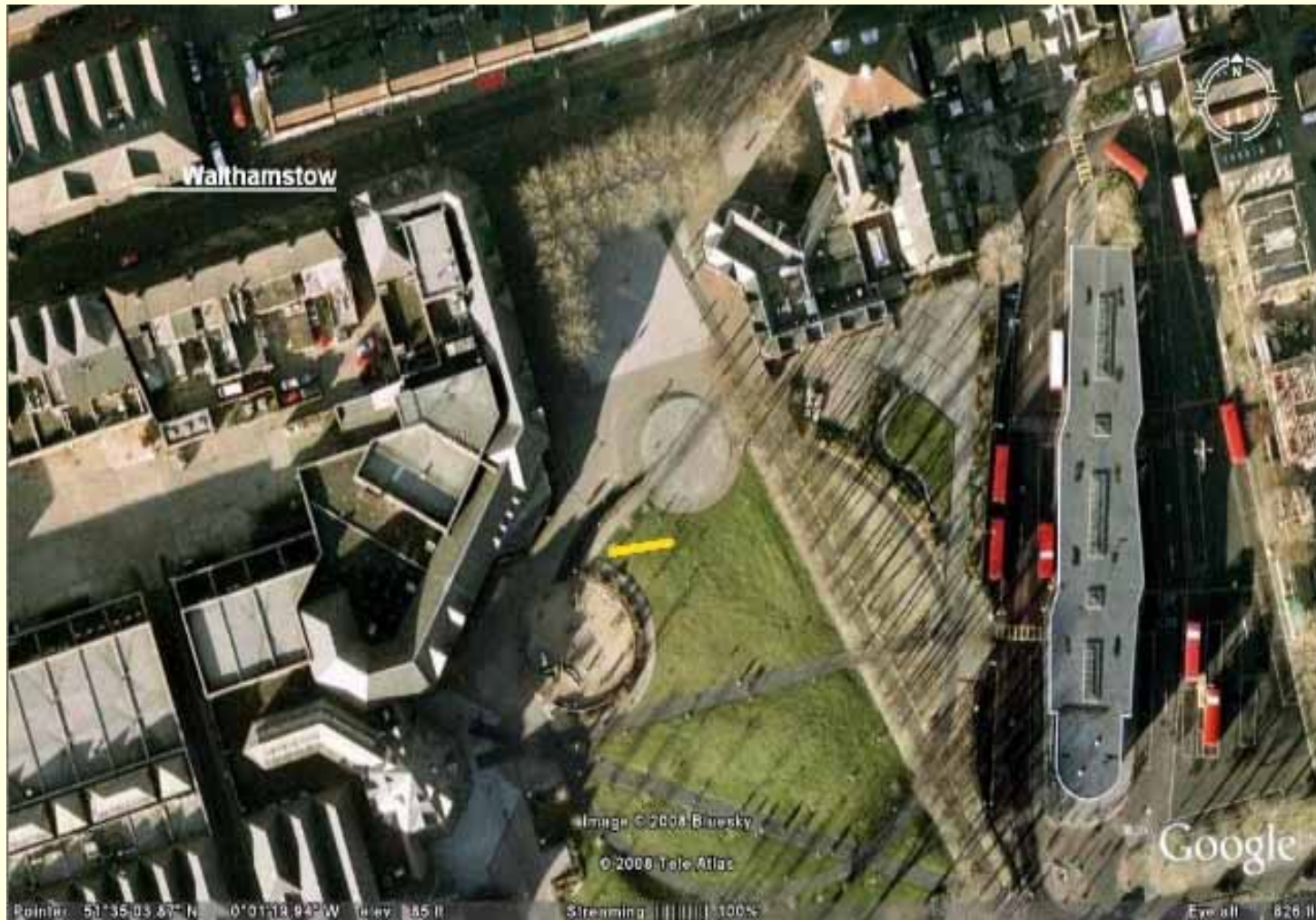
