A representative from Ascham Homes will be available for any tenant and leasehold issues.

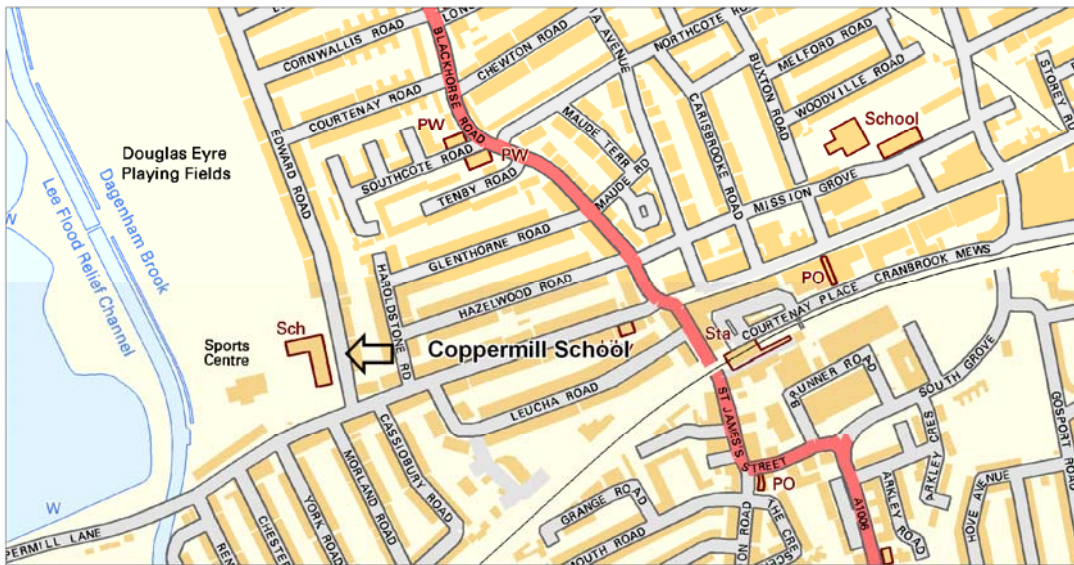
#### **Willowfield School**
